Cervical Cancer Education and Screening

Education

- Over 470 participants in the Navigation Program received one-on-one (via telephone) education about the importance of cervical cancer screening
- Over 470 participants in the Navigation Program received written materials and resources (via mail) for cervical cancer screening
- 3 community programs included information about cervical cancer screening and resources for 43 participants
- Staff attended over 15 health fairs where cervical cancer screening materials were distributed with the potential to reach over 1400 attendees

Screening

- 258 participants in the Navigation Program received cervical cancer screenings
- All participants were connected or re-connected to a medical home
- 11 pap tests were reported as abnormal and required additional diagnostic testing
- 16 diagnostic tests were completed including ultrasounds, colposcopies, LEEP, and repeat pap tests

Treatment

- One patient was diagnosed with cervical cancer and surgery is scheduled

Education

- Over 325 participants in the Navigation Program received one-on-one (via telephone) education about the importance of breast cancer screening
- Over 325 participants in the Navigation Program received written materials and resources (via mail) for breast cancer screening
- 4 community programs included information about breast cancer screening and resources for 80 participants
- Staff attended over 15 health fairs where breast cancer screening materials were distributed with the potential to reach over 1400 attendees

Screening

- 195 participants in the Navigation Program received breast cancer screenings
- All participants were connected or re-connected to a medical home
- 21 mammograms were reported as abnormal and required additional diagnostic testing
- 34 diagnostic tests were completed including ultrasounds, additional mammography films, and biopsies

Treatment

- Two patients were diagnosed with breast cancer; one patient received surgery, radiation and hormone therapies and one required surgery only

Colon Cancer Education and Screening

Education

- Over 385 participants in the Navigation Program received one-on-one (via telephone) education about the importance of colon cancer screening
- Over 385 participants in the Navigation Program received written materials and resources (via mail) for colon cancer screening
- 9 community programs included information about colon cancer screening and resources for 367 participants
- Staff attended over 15 health fairs where colon cancer screening materials were distributed with the potential to reach over 1400 attendees

Screening

- 84 participants in the Navigation Program received colon cancer screenings
- All participants were connected or re-connected to a medical home
- 9 colon screenings were reported as abnormal and required additional diagnostic testing
- 6 diagnostic tests were completed including colonoscopies and polypectomies with biopsies
- 1 diagnostic colonoscopy on hold due to treatment for another cancer and 2 colonoscopies scheduled

Treatment

- Three patients were diagnosed with colorectal cancer; two patients received surgical resections with no other treatment required and one patient is currently undergoing metastatic work-up prior to making a treatment decision
